

**DALLAS CUP
HOMESTAY PROGRAM AGREEMENT**

Perhaps the most rewarding experience of every Dallas Cup is the Dallas Cup HomeStay Program, where local Dallas Cup soccer families host visiting international team players. To maximize the enjoyment of this experience by both the international players and the Dallas host families, it is important that all participating family members have a full understanding of the program and complete this HomeStay Agreement.

**INTERNATIONAL HOMESTAY TEAM
* TERMS OF HOMESTAY PROGRAM CONTRACT ***

- Have to apply & be selected for Dallas Cup HomeStay program.
 - The DC HomeStay Program for international teams is limited to a **maximum** of twenty-two (22) players. All remaining members of the traveling party are required to make their own arrangements for room and board and are responsible for any and all costs involved. Hotel reservations for all adult members of the delegations (staff and supporters) one must be made at one of the designated Dallas Cup hotels as defined in the "Invitation Instructions."
 - The HomeStay Program for international teams will not exceed ten (10) nights. Players may not begin their stay any earlier than Friday prior to the tournament week and must end their stay on Monday following the conclusion of the tournament. Dallas Cup HomeStay provides sleeping accommodations and two (2) meals per day, breakfast, and dinner, for each player. If a team wishes to arrive earlier or stay later, the team is responsible for making those arrangements and for making those arrangements and for all costs involved.
- * International clubs selected for the HomeStay Program are responsible for: (a) all of their players from approximately **8:30 am to 5:00 pm daily**; (b) local transportation in the form of a van, bus, or car rental sufficient to transport the entire traveling party and luggage; (c) cost of all entertainment activities selected during the tournament week; (d) setting a schedule (e) any additional meal(s) for the team.
- * International Dallas Cup HomeStay teams are required to furnish (as a condition of acceptance to the tournament): (a) a Club/Team Liability/Medical/Media Release & Indemnity Agreement form, signed by an authorized team representative. The international team authorized team rep accepts all financial responsibility for the medical treatment of housed players during their stay in Texas.
- * International HomeStay teams are required to provide the name of an English-speaking contact and an **email address, and a 24-hour phone number** for necessary communication with the host team beginning approximately six (6) weeks prior to arrival in Dallas. In order to arrange appropriate accommodations for the players, there should be frequent communication between the teams & families. Response to any communication within 24 hours is expected and appreciated.

**DALLAS HOST TEAM
* TERMS OF HOMESTAY PROGRAM CONTRACT ***

- * Host families are responsible for international players from approximately 5:00 pm to 8:30 am daily. International team adults shall be responsible for their players from approximately 8:30 am to 5:00 pm daily. Dallas host families may accept the additional responsibility from 8:30 am to 5:00 pm at their option.
- Host families will accommodate a minimum of two players per host family.
 - The host family is required to be prepared to provide at least two meals daily, sleeping arrangements **(under adult supervision)** for each international guest, and transportation to and from the international team's designated meeting point for their daily team activities as directed by the team's coach.
 - The host families are also required to provide transportation to and from the international team's point of arrival/departure in Dallas (i.e., DFW, Love field)
 - All adult members of the host team (18 years and older) directly involved with the DC HomeStay Program are required to complete a Background History Check process as directed by the Dallas Cup Inc. office.
